Circus is coming to town May 24

Special Meeting , Jan. 2011 A special meeting of the Board of Directors was called to meet with a representative (Doug) of Culpepper & Merriweather Circus.

Terms and concerns were discussed. A check for \$290 was needed up front if the circus was confirmed. Advanced tickets are \$9 adults, \$6 kids. Chamber would get 25 percent of the first 100 adult tickets. Day of event tickets are \$12 and \$7.

Circus would call on merchants six weeks in advance to sell tickets. Chamber would make 25 percent on pre sale of these.

Circus will put up 100 window cards or fliers well in advance. A clown will be available one week in advance to talk to school children.


The circus would provide an insert for the newspaper free of charge, with insert costs to be paid for by Chamber or donated by newspaper.

Tent raising would be at 10 a.m. morning of the one-day show.

Tent capacity is 700.

The board expressed concern over the previous year (2 years ago) when flyers were not distributed well in advance nor were tickets to business people.

Joni Parsons agreed to find a location, which needs to be about 150x250. Confirmation is needed by May 1. The board was in agreement to hold the circus May 24.



The board of directors meeting was called to order by President Jonathan Bilden at 7 a.m. at Moozie's Café. Minutes of the December board meeting were approved.

The board agreed to take the \$198.32 that has been running in a Neighborhood Watch Fund and transfer it into the General Fund because there is no Neighborhood Watch.

The financial report was approved.

Sandi Erskine, Bob Pinnell and Jonathan will act as the budget committee. Sandi reported the difference between the estimated budget and the actual budget showed a deficit of \$2,583.


