

## Nominations wanted for VP and Secretary

Chamber President Sandi Erskine, in accordance with the by-laws, has selected a nominating committee. The bylaws say:

Article VII, Section I of the by-laws says: "A nominating committee consisting of a chairman and two members of the Eagle Point Chamber of Commerce shall be appointed by the president and approved by Board of Directors in October of each year.

Section 2: The nominating committee shall:

a. submit the names of two candidates, if possible, from the members of the Eagle Point Chamber of Commerce for each elective office to be filled;

b. review the bylaws with and obtain consent of all nominees to serve if elected.

c. prepare mail ballots with the names listed in alphabetical order for each office to be mailed by Nov. 10 or within five days after the November meeting if held after Nov. 6.

Section 3:

Nominations for elected officers may be made from the floor at the November meeting provided consent of the nominee has been secured. Such nominations shall be added to the mail ballot.

The nominating committee chairman recommended by the president is Kathy Sell with committee members Ken Newcomb and Tamara McMahan. They will be subject to approval by the board of directors at the Oct. 6 meeting.

The nominating committee will be seeking nominations for the office of president-elect and secretary. Those

members wanting to be considered for either of the positions should speak to a member of the nominating committee at

the Oct. 6 meeting. They hope to present a slate of at least two members for each of the two openings.

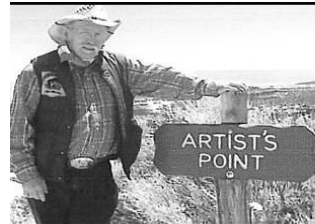
