Chamber to meet on August 31

The next Chamber of Commerce meeting will be held on Monday, Aug. 31 at the Ashpole Center. The decision was made to hold the meeting earlier because the Labor Day weekend is the first weekend in September.

Dave Hussell, Eagle Point City Administrator and Melissa Owen, business manager, will be making a presentation on the Transportation Utility Fee (better known as the TUF) fee.
